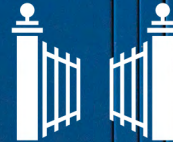

College Possible has been the leader in college access and success for Omaha metro area students since 2011.

College Possible offers an intensive curriculum of coaching and support. Led by talented and idealistic AmeriCorps members serving as near-peer coaches, high school students participate in more than 320 hours of college preparation throughout their junior and senior years.

We build a community of support among our like-minded, college-bound students to serve as an additional source of encouragement for one another.

After high school, College Possible students receive continued coaching through college, with graduation rates nearly equal to those of students from all income groups.

For Karina, a first generation college student, graduation in 2019 with a Bachelor’s degree in social work comes after receiving a full-ride Thompson Learning Community Scholarship at UNO. She is completing a two-year internship as a mentor to students at TLC, co-facilitating a seminar course, being a wife and mother to her year-and-a-half old child and sometimes providing childcare for her 10- and 6-year old siblings.

“I used to doubt myself,” said Karina, “**College Possible** has proven the only limits I face are the ones I set myself.”

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As participants in **College Possible**,

High School Juniors

- find best 'fit' colleges
- visit campuses
- complete ACT/SAT registration and receive essay strategies
- learn about college costs and receive financial aid coaching
- set goals
- receive intensive ACT/SAT test preparation

High School Seniors

- engage in intensive college application assistance
- receive scholarship application coaching
- are given financial literacy and aid coaching
- learn professional essay and communication skills
- prepare for transition to college life

College Students

- connect to campus resources and opportunities
- receive ongoing financial aid coaching
- develop study skills and self-advocacy
- tackle barriers to persistence
- identify future opportunities
